

## **Air Cargo Security - Conditions for Disqualification, Suspension and Revocation**

The Director of Civil Aviation may disqualify, suspend and/or revoke the holder of this certificate if:

- A. The holder fails to comply with the requirements as prescribed under SA-CARS 108 and document SA-CATS 108;
- B. The holder fails to comply with the requirements as outlined in the approved Air Cargo Security Manual (ACSM);
- C. The holder fails to display the certificate visibly at its facility where the operation takes place;
- D. The holder or any other person in the employ of the holder obstructs an Authorised Officer/ Inspector from carrying out his/her duties;
- E. The holder or any other person in the employ of the holder misrepresents the status of a material defect in the security system(s) of the holder to the Authorised Officer/Inspector;
- F. The holder fails to disclose in advance a material defect in the security system(s) or methods used to secure cargo intended for carriage on an air carrier's aircraft ;
- G. The holder fails to submit documentation or proof required to address findings raised during an Audit/Inspection within the stipulated time;
- H. The holder fails to apply security controls including physical checks or screening in accordance with its approved ACSM;
- I. The holder uses screeners that are not specifically trained and certified to perform the function of screening air cargo;
- J. The holder fails to submit an application and proof of payment as prescribed by SA-CARS 187, no later than two months before the date on which such approval expires; or
- K. The holder is found to be in contravention of the Civil Aviation Regulations, 2011;.

The Director of Civil Aviation may invoke Part 185 of the South African Civil Aviation Regulations to effect the above conditions.
